**Notes:**

- (1) Pensions data is provided by six pension paying authorities: NICS Pensions; NILGOSC; Teachers' Pensions; Health Pensions; NIFRS Pensions; and Assembly Pensions.
- (2) The Northern Ireland Housing Executive is the only participating organisation which submits housing benefit data.
- (3) The Northern Ireland Housing Executive is the only participating organisation which submits housing tenants, right to buy and social housing waiting list data.
- (4) Private supported care home residents data is provided only by Belfast, Northern, South Eastern, Southern and Western Health and Social Care Trusts.
- (5) The Department for Infrastructure is the only participating organisation which submits blue badges and taxi licences data.
- (6) Translink is the only participating organisation which submits concessionary travel passes data.
- (7) The Department of Finance is the only participating organisation which submits rates data.
- (8) The Department of Finance is the only participating organisation which submits Lone Pensioner Allowance data. LPA is rate relief awarded to those aged 70 or over and living alone. The Department for Communities submits state pension data to facilitate one of the LPA data matches.
- (9) Home Office immigration data is currently not included in NFI data matching but may be reintroduced in the future.
